

Workforce Development Transfer Scholarship Fact Sheet

Scholarship program will:

1. Provide two \$2,900 scholarships to second year students who plan to earn a degree from KCTCS and are transferring to a Kentucky public or independent four-year college/university.
2. Provide one \$2,100 scholarship to a first year student who plans to earn a degree from KCTCS and transfer to a Kentucky public or independent four-year college/university. This scholarship is renewable at \$2,900 provided the student maintains good academic standing in year one.

Criteria:

1. Enroll full or part time and are degree seeking
2. Enroll in the STEM disciplines, health professions, career pathway programs, teacher shortage areas, or applied sciences.
3. Declare their intent to pursue an associate's degree in an area of workforce need at a KCTCS institution
4. Enter a KCTCS institution in good academic standing and maintain that standing while enrolled.
5. Declare their intent to pursue a baccalaureate degree upon graduating from KCTCS with an associate's degree.
