

NAA 100 Online Nursing Assistant Skills I

3 college credit hours - Financial Aid may be available

Students must speak with the Nursing Department before enrolling in the online course. Self-enrollment is not permitted.



NAA100 is offered each semester. Even if the semester has begun, you may still be able to enroll in the online class. New classes begin every Monday through the 11th week of the semester.

This course will provide knowledge and skills for the nurse aide to assume the role and responsibilities required in a long term care setting. The focus is on communication, infection control, safety, resident/patient rights, and basic nursing skills.

Part 1 is facilitated by an online instructor and is comprised of textbook reading, quizzes, and four graded exams.

Part 2 includes hands on learning and practice of nurse aide skills in a nursing clinical lab. Students attend 2 1/2 days in either **Hopkinsville or Louisville, KY**. Part 2 dates are pre-determined and based on instructor availability. Most dates will be in Hopkinsville. Sessions in Louisville will only be held if the minimum student number is met.

Part 3 includes 16 hours of clinical experience in a long term care facility under the supervision of a licensed nurse. Clinical experiences may be available in **Hopkinsville, Auburn, and London, KY as well as in Clarksville, TN**.

Class Requirements:

- Proof of negative TB test (*Effective 9/1/2016: 2-step TB test required*)
- Hepatitis B series, titer, or declination form
- BLS for Healthcare Providers CPR certification through American Heart Association
- Liability insurance (\$11 fee assessed at time of registration per semester)
- Background check/Document manager approximately \$60 through a vendor designated by HCC (*Certain items on the background check may affect your ability to attend clinical. Please contact the Nursing department for further information.*)
- Statement of Understanding
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 50 pounds

Completion of the NAA 100 class will allow the student to sit for the state nurse aide registry exam, which is a requirement for the HCC RN and PN programs.

The **Kentucky Nurse Aide Registry exam** is offered on the Hopkinsville Campus. After successful completion of NAA 100, you have **one year** from the course completion date to take the state nurse aide registry exam.
